World Premiere of Civil Rights-Themed Song Cycle by KSC Professor

In 2019, Keene State College Professor of Music, Heather Gilligan, DMA, was commissioned by Atlanta-based Kinnara, one of the nation's premier professional chamber choirs, to write a 25-minute work for vocal quartet and percussion that focuses on issues of civil rights and social justice. Gilligan devoted a year and a half to the work, titled "Southern Dissonance: Portraits of a New South," and Kinnara premiered the song cycle on January 14, 2022 in Huntsville, AL. With texts by John Lewis, Stacy Abrams, Martin Luther King, Alice Walker, Langston Hughes, and Jimmy Carter – all southern activists, many of whom are Atlanta-based, the work is about progress and persistence. Gilligan said of the piece: "Uniting texts by a variety of writers and political figures from the Civil Rights Movement to present day, the composition weaves together themes that are as relevant now as they were then, exploring issues of voter rights and the idea of standing one's ground. In addition to the premiere in Huntsville, the piece was also performed in Atlanta, GA, both during Martin Luther King weekend. It will also be recorded and published. Congratulations, Heather!



Keene State College Recognized as a Top Overall Performer in Campus Sustainability

Royal Recognition for Keene State Alumna

Eliza Maher Hasselquist '99 graduated from Keene State with a passion for biology and a solid introduction to the research process. Now living in Sweden, she is employed as a researcher while pursuing her Ph.D in biology and ecology at the Swedish University of Agricultural Sciences' Department of Forest Ecology and Management in Umeå.

In December 2021, King Carl XVI Gustaf of Sweden presented a scholarship to Eliza for her lead on a project to research management of forest growth close to wetlands. The King Carl XVI Gustaf 50th Anniversary Fund for Science, Technology and the Environment award is intended to promote research, technical development and enterprise that contributes to the sustainable use of natural resources and the preservation of biological diversity. Eliza's work explores how specific actions affect water quality and /or tree growth in terms of both economic and climate impact.

When asked what inspires her scientific pursuits Eliza says, "Humans have a hard time dealing with uncertainty, and it's important for science to put that uncertainty into context. Research provides information that contributes to making informed choices about the environment." Eliza attributes her career choice in part to undergraduate research opportunities with Keene State professors, Suzanne Whittemore and Renate Gebauer. Congratulations, Eliza!

The Keene State College Holocaust and Genocide Studies Program is an acknowledged leader in the field of genocide studies and prevention. Its Summer Institute offers educational leaders from around the world the instruction to develop and provide curriculum focused on genocide prevention to a new generation of students. Attendees who complete the Institute join a global corps of educators who serve as leaders in Holocaust and genocide education in their schools, communities, and professional organizations. In recognition of the leadership of the Summer Institute's director, Cohen Professor of Holocaust and Genocide Studies Jim Waller, the Charles E. Scheidt Family Foundation has committed to underwriting the Summer Institute for the next five years, with support totaling \$300,000.

Waller expressed his gratitude for the Scheidt Family Foundation's commitment and vote of confidence in HGS's global outreach: "Through our previous Institutes, we've seen a remarkable growth of collaboration and teaching in genocide prevention among our alumni. 
