SCIENCES/MATHEMATICS:

A minimum of **four** courses totaling at least **12** credits, as follows:

- One course in Biology.
- One course in Physical Science (ASTR, CHEM, GEOL, MET, PHYS)
- Two additional courses from Sciences/Mathematics: ASTR, BIO, CHEM, CS, ENST, GEOL, MATH, MET, PHYS or an approved interdisciplinary courses (IDSM).

**Courses, if appropriate, taken for the American Studies major may count toward the Arts and Humanities component or the Social Sciences component of the General Education requirements. Some courses in the major may have required prerequisites that may satisfy either General Education or elective requirements.

MAJOR REQUIREMENTS: 37 credits (minimum) Each student must confer with a core American Studies faculty member in planning a course of study. **Note:** Any course marked with an asterisk (*) may not always be appropriate for the American Studies major. Courses, if appropriate, taken for the American Studies major may count toward the Arts and Humanities component or the Social Sciences component of the General Education requirements.

The student must demonstrate proficiency in a language other than English as specified by the Language Requirement for Students with majors in the Division of Arts and Humanities. See catalog for complete policy statement. Courses taken to fulfill this requirement may be applied to General Education requirements in Arts and Humanities.
