The economics minor consists of five additional courses (15 credits) in Economics beyond ECON 201 and 202. Of these five courses, at least one must be an intermediate level theory course (ECON 301 or 302) and one must emphasize either history (ECON 450 or 455) or critical studies (ECON 320 350 or 375).

*ECON 201-202 may be used to satisfy the Social Sciences component of the General Education requirements. Mathematics competence at the level of MATH 141, introductory Statistics, is highly recommended.
