FRENCH MINOR**

The French minor serves the needs of students planning to acquire an active command of French while majoring in another subject.

*New students will be assigned to the proper course on the basis of placement interviews with the Modern Language faculty. In general, however, students who have had no prior instruction or experience with a language should register for 101. Students with one or two years of successful high school study should register for 102. Students with three or more years should register for 201. Exceptions to these guidelines will be granted only by the Modern Language faculty.

NO CREDIT WILL BE GRANTED FOR FR 101 IF THE STUDENT ENROLLED HAS SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED MORE THAN TWO YEARS OF THE SAME LANGUAGE IN HIGH SCHOOL. NO CREDIT WILL BE GRANTED FOR FR 102 IF THE STUDENT ENROLLED HAS SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED AT LEAST THREE YEARS OF THE SAME LANGUAGE IN HIGH SCHOOL.

Courses taken for the minor may also be used to fulfill the Arts & Humanities component of the General Education requirements.
