SPANISH MINOR**

The Spanish minor allows students to acquire an active command of Spanish while majoring in another subject. Natural combinations are Spanish with Management, Computer Science, Industrial Chemistry, or Industrial Technology.

New students will be assigned to the proper course on the basis of placement interviews with the Modern Language faculty. In general, however, students who have no prior instruction or experience with a language should register for SP 101. Students with one or two years of successful high school study should register for SP 102. Students with three or more years should register for SP 201. Exceptions to these guidelines will be granted only by the Modern Language faculty.

NO CREDIT WILL BE GRANTED FOR SP 101 IF THE STUDENT ENROLLED HAS SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED MORE THAN TWO YEARS OF THE SAME LANGUAGE IN HIGH SCHOOL. NO CREDIT WILL BE GRANTED FOR SP 102 IF THE STUDENT ENROLLED HAS SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED MORE THAN THREE YEARS OF THE SAME LANGUAGE IN HIGH SCHOOL.

Courses taken for the minor may be used to fulfill the Arts & Humanities component of the General Education requirements.
