A. B. **Arts & Humanities: Three** courses totaling at least nine credits from at least two Arts & Humanities disciplines: AMST, ART, COMM, FILM, GER, HIST, JRN, ML, MU, PHIL, SP, TAD or an approved interdisciplinary course (designated IDAH)..

C. **Social Sciences:** Two courses totaling at least six credits from two of the following disciplines: ECON, GEOG, POSC, PSYC, SOC or an approved interdisciplinary course (designated IDSS).

D. **Math/Science:** Two courses totaling at least six credits from **two** of the following disciplines: ASTR, BIO, CHEM, CS, ENST, GEOL, MATH, MET, PHYS or an approved interdisciplinary course (designated IDSM).

II. **SELF-DESIGNED COMPONENT:**

A self-designed concentration must include at least 36 credit hours, 18 of which must be at the 200 level or higher. Up to two disciplines may be included; one of the disciplines must consist of at least 12 credits.
