**GENERAL EDUCATION** (minimum 33 credits)

**WRITING REQUIREMENT:** (3-4 credits)

**ARTS & HUMANITIES:**

A minimum of **12** credits, as follows:

- One course in Literature.

(Any 200- or 300-level English course except 202, 203, 204, 208, 301, 302, 303, 304, 308, 312; FR 303 and SP 303 may also be used to fulfill this requirement)

- One course in History.

• Additional credits in Arts & Humanities: AMST, ART, COMM, ENG, FILM, FR, GER, HIST, JRN, ML, MU, PHIL, SP, TAD, an interdisciplinary course (WS 201\* or IDAH), or an Integrative Studies course with the prefix *IA* or *IH*.

**SOCIAL SCIENCES:**

A minimum of **9** credits in **three** or more Social Sciences disciplines: ANTH, ECON, GEOG, POSC, PSYC, SOC, an interdisciplinary course (WS 201\* or IDSS), or an Integrative Studies course with the prefix *IS*.

**SCIENCES/MATHEMATICS:**

A minimum of **9** credits, as follows:

- One course in Biology.

• One course in Physical Science (ASTR, CHEM, GEOL, MET, PHYS).

• Additional credits from Sciences/Mathematics: ASTR, BIO, CHEM, CS, ENST, GEOL, MATH, MET, PHYS, an approved interdisciplinary courses (IQL or IDSM), or an Integrative Studies course with the prefix *IN*.

# SPECIFIC GEN ED REQUIREMENTS BY MAJOR

AH = Arts & Humanities; SS = Social Sciences; SM = Sciences/Mathematics

*Please consult with your advisor if you have question regarding major requirements.*

**AMERICAN STUDIES:** Major requirements may fulfill all AH and SS requirements.

**APPLIED COMPUTER SCIENCE:** MATH 141 is required in SM.

**BIOLOGY (BA and BS):** Major requirements fulfill all SM requirements.

**CHEMISTRY (BA and BS):** Major requirements fulfill all SM requirements except BIO.

**CHEMISTRY/PHYSICS:** MATH 151 and MATH 152 are required in SM; major requirements fulfill the Physical Science requirement in SM; BIO is still needed.

**COMPUTER MATHEMATICS:** Major requirements fulfill all SM requirements except BIO.

**ECONOMICS:** A PHIL class is required in AH.

**EDUCATION:** A HIST course is required in AH; a GEOG course is required in SS.

**In addition: Early Childhood:** ENG 286 fulfills the Literature requirement in AH; an ART course or a MU course is required in AH; MATH 171 is required in SM.

*Elementary Education and Elementary Special Education:* an ART course or a MU course is required in AH; MATH 171 and MATH 172 are required in SM.

*Middle/Junior High Mathematics:* PHYS 241 and CS 140 are required in SM.

*Secondary Special Education:* MATH 171 and MATH 172 are required in SM.

**ENVIRONMENTAL STUDIES (both options):** ENG 202 fulfills one requirement in AH; major requirements fulfill all SS and SM requirements.

**GENERAL SCIENCE:** A US HIST course is required in AH; a GEOG course is required in SS; major requirements fulfill all SM requirements.

**GEOLOGY:** Major requirements fulfill all SM requirements.

**HEALTH SCIENCE:** All options require COMM 171 in AH; PSYC 101 in SS; BIO 230/231, BIO 232/233, and CHEM 103/107 in SM. **In addition: Nutrition** also requires CHEM 220/224 in SM.

**MANAGEMENT:** COMM 171 is required in AH; ECON 201 and ECON 202 are required in SS; CS 101 is required in SM.

**MATHEMATICS:** All options require PHYS 241 and CS 140 in SM. **In addition: Middle/Junior High and Secondary** options also require US HIST in AH and GEOG in SS.

**MATHEMATICS-PHYSICS:** Major requirements fulfill all SM requirements.

**MUSIC EDUCATION:** A US HIST and MU 114 are required in AH; a GEOG course is required in SS.

**PHYSICAL EDUCATION:** For both options, BIO 230/231 and BIO 232/233 are required in SM. In addition, *Athletic Training* requires PSYC 101 in SS and CHEM 103/107 in SM; *Teacher Certification* requires a US HIST course in AH, a GEOG course in SS, and CHEM 100 in SM.

**PHYSICAL SCIENCE:** A US HIST course is required in AH; GEOG 204 is required in SS; MATH 141 and MATH 151 are required in SM; major requirements fulfill the Physical Science requirement in SM; BIO is still needed.

**SAFETY STUDIES:** CHEM 103/107 is required in SM.

**SOCIAL SCIENCE:** HIST 161 and HIST 162 are required in AH; major requirements can fulfill one AH requirement; PSYC 101, ECON 201, SOC 101, and POSC 201 or POSC 205 are required in SS.

**TECHNOLOGY STUDIES:** For both options, MATH 120 is required in SM.

**THEATRE & DANCE:** For all options, TAD 101 is required in AH.
