

DISCLOSURE OF CAMPUS CRIME STATISTICS¹

Annually, the associate director of Campus Safety makes a good faith effort to compile crime statistics as required by the Jeanne Clery Act.² Statistics are obtained from Campus Safety incident reports, Student Conduct Office, Campus Security Authorities as defined by federal regulations, Keene Police Department, and all other law enforcement agencies with jurisdiction over properties owned and controlled by Keene State College.

- Requests for crime information are submitted in writing.
- Law enforcement agencies with jurisdiction over properties owned and controlled by Keene State College provide arrest statistics regarding alcohol, weapon, and drug arrests on and in the area surrounding campus.
- The director of Student Conduct compiles statistics on disciplinary referrals for drug and alcohol violations, which are provided to the associate director of Campus Safety for inclusion in the report.
- It is the practice of the College that incidents reported to other offices are referred to Campus Safety for documentation and follow-up as needed.

The following table contains crime statistics for calendar years 2012, 2013, and 2014, in accordance with Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) procedures and the *Clery Act*.

³ Implemented in 2014, *The Campus Sexual Violence Elimination Act* aims to increase transparency about the scope of sexual violence on campus, guarantee victims enhanced rights, provide for standards in institutional conduct proceedings, and provide campus communitywide prevention educational programming. Such measures are expected to increase awareness, bystander intervention, and reporting of sexual violence.

* Incidents where there was a violation of law that resulted in a referral to the college's student conduct system without any criminal process. In 2014, 90 liquor law referrals and 14 drug law violations were referred to Student Conduct between the dates of October 16-19, 2014 as a result of activities related to the Keene Pumpkin Festival.

** The *Arrest* category also includes persons who were not arrested but summonsed to court. If an incident resulted in both criminal process and a referral to the college's conduct system, it is counted only once under the arrest category.

*** The *Total on Campus* category includes all on-campus incidents, including those listed in the subsequent categories: *Number in dormitories or other residential facilities* and *Number in non-residential facilities*. Therefore, the two categories are not cumulative, but duplicative.

**** Beginning with statistics for the calendar year 2013, *Dating Violence*, *Domestic Violence* and *Stalking* will be included in the annual *KSC Campus Crime and Fire Safety Report* in compliance with statutory changes brought forth by the *Violence Against Women Reauthorization Act of 2013* and amendments to the *Higher Education Opportunity Act of 2008*. Statistics for previous years are not available.

*****Beginning with statistics for calendar year 2014, the category *Unfounded by law enforcement* will be included in the KSC Campus Crime Statistics. If a crime is reported as occurring *on campus*, in or on *non-campus buildings or property*, or on *public property*, and the reported crime is investigated by law enforcement authorities and found to be false or baseless, the crime is considered to be "unfounded" and will not otherwise be counted as a crime statistic. Only sworn or commissioned law enforcement personnel may unfind a crime.

*****Crime statistics for Domestic Violence was over reported in 2014. This report reflects the accurate statistics to include 1 incident *on campus*, occurring in a *non-residential facility*, and 0 incidents *in or on a non-campus building or property*.

Hate-Motivated Crimes

A *Hate Crime* is a criminal offense in which the defendant intentionally selects a victim (or in the case of a property crime, the property that is the object of the crime), because of the actual or perceived race, religion, national origin, ethnicity, gender, disability, gender identity, or sexual orientation of any person (*Uniform Crime Reporting*). The following table contains hate-motivated crime statistics for calendar years 2012, 2013, and 2014:

*Numbers indicate the number of incidents, out of the total for each category, which were motivated by a specific type of bias. The form of bias is identified following the number.

** The *Total on Campus* category includes all on-campus incidents, including those listed in the categories below, “Number in dormitories or other residential facilities” and “Number in non-residential facilities.” Therefore, the two categories are not cumulative, but duplicative.

***This category includes all crimes identified by the *Clery Act* as well as any other crimes that are not identified by the *Clery Act*, but cause bodily injury to the victim. Reported statistics are duplicative if they are a result of a *Clery* crime noted in parenthesis.

****Hate crime statistics for 2012 were re-evaluated to ensure accurate and consistent reporting with the 2013 statistics. Upon re-evaluation, it was determined that hate crime statistics in 2012 were over-reported in 2013 *KSC Campus Crime and Fire Safety Report*. The total hate crime statistics have been adjusted from fifteen to three in 2012.

***** Beginning with statistics for calendar year 2014, the category *Unfounded by law enforcement* will be included in the KSC Campus Crime Statistics.

Statistical Geography⁴

On-campus buildings and properties include all properties owned by Keene State College within the contiguous area of the main campus at 229 Main Street, Athletic Facilities off Krif Road, property and walkway at Martell Court, athletic facilities north of Route 101, and the Winchester Street parking lot. For a complete list of on-campus buildings and properties, see the campus map attached at the end of this document (not to scale). The following locations are considered *Non-Campus Buildings* for the purposes of the *Clery Act* and crime statistics. These locations are included in the Non-Campus Buildings column in the above chart:

- College camp on Page Court in Swanzey, NH
- Property at Nubanusit Lake

The following locations are considered *public property* for the purposes of the *Clery Act* and crime statistics:

- Main St. - Sidewalk, street and opposite sidewalk/crosswalk between 229 and 361 Main Street
- Winchester St. - Sidewalk, street and opposite sidewalk/crosswalk between the Main Street Rotary and 322 Winchester Street
- Ashuelot Rail Trail between Winchester Street and Krif Road
- Martel Court from Rt. 12/101 underpass to Athletic Facilities off Krif Road
- Bruder Court and Appleton Street
- Sidewalk, street and opposite sidewalk between the Ashuelot Rail Trail and Route 12A on Route 12/Route 101
- Any other public locations immediately adjacent to and accessible from the campus.

⁴ The statistical geography of the athletic complex off Krif Road and the Winchester Street parking lot were changed in 2014 from non-campus property to on-campus property. Statistics in 2012 and 2013 are not impacted by this change as no *Clery* crimes were reported in these areas during 2012 or 2013.
