New Hampshire Residency Statement

Payment of property and/or residency taxes does not constitute the basis for a claim of legal domicile. Dependent students whose parents are divorced or legally separated where one, and only one, of the parents is domiciled in New Hampshire are advised to have that parent inform us in notarized letter of his/her legal custody of the student or that he/she provides more than one-half of the student's total financial support. *New Hampshire residents who are military personnel on assignment outside the state* and who are applying for admission or have dependents doing so, should submit a statement establishing that they entered the armed forces as residents of the state of New Hampshire. This statement should be certified by a commanding officer. The "Rules Governing Tuition for the University System of New Hampshire" may be obtained by writing the Admissions Office. Misrepresentation of facts to establish claim to New Hampshire domicile will be viewed as justification for revoking an acceptance or returning an application without consideration. **Per NH House Bill 624, approved June 2014, that 12 month waiting period is waived for US military veterans.**
