About the Board of Directors

The 16-member KSC Alumni Association Board of Directors is responsible for directing policies and programs of the Association that promote the welfare of alumni and Keene State College.

The work of the Association's Board of Directors is carried out through standing committees of the Board. These committees cover such areas as communication, honors and awards, advocacy, nominations, cultivation/events, strategic planning, and finance. Ad hoc committees are also formed to perform special work.

The Board of Directors holds meetings annually in Keene. At its meetings, the Board transacts Association business and discusses the strategic direction of the Association and how to best involve alumni in the advancement of the College. In addition, the Board frequently interfaces with students, campus administrators, community leaders, state and federal legislators, and faculty.
