



The Cohen Center for Holocaust Studies requirements for the service commitment in respect of the CCHS Fellows are as follows:

1. The duration of the service commitment of a Cohen Center Fellow is two years.
2. The Fellow must serve as a regional contact and run (or co-run) two regional teacher sharing meetings
3. The Fellow must participate in at least one of the following during his/her service commitment:
 - Present a workshop at a professional conference
 - Write an article for a newspaper or professional journal
 - Conduct a book discussion in your community or a present a lecture
 - Develop a lesson plan for distribution
 - An approved idea not listed above
4. The Fellow may serve as a member of the Educational Outreach Advisory Board for the duration of the service commitment.
