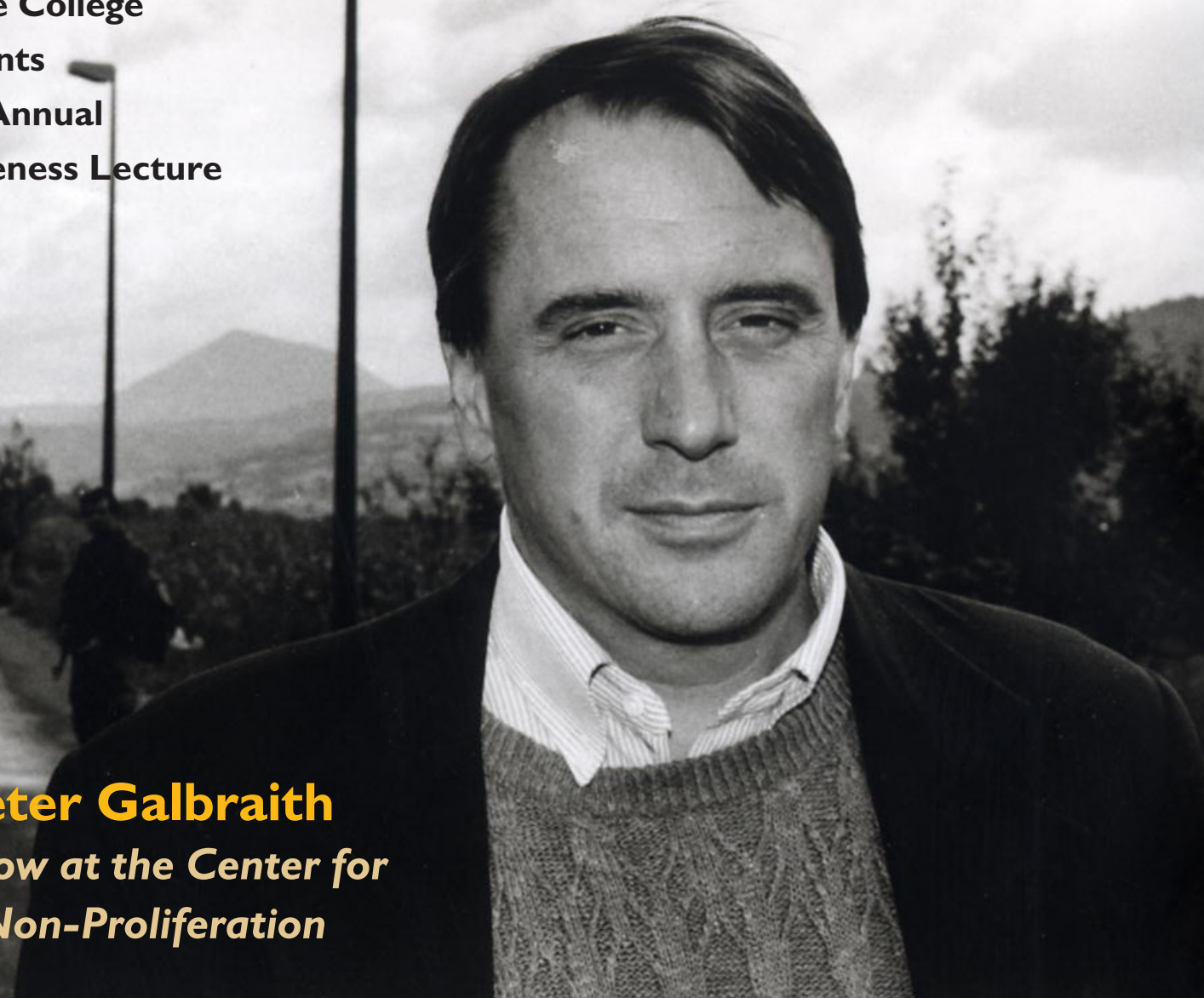

Peter W. Galbraith served as the first U.S. Ambassador to Croatia and has held senior positions in the U.S. government and the United Nations. In the late 1980s, Galbraith helped expose Saddam Hussein's murderous "al-Anfal" campaign against the Iraqi Kurds. His written and televised accounts provided early warning of the catastrophe overtaking the civilian population. Galbraith has worked on Iraq issues for more than 25 years and is the author of the critically acclaimed book, *The End of Iraq: How American Incompetence Created a War Without End*.
