

# Statistics About The Genocide

- The death toll has reached at least 70,000 since March (some say it is around 300,000)
- More than 1,000 people die each day
- More than 2 million people have been driven from their homes
- More than 175,000 have fled to refugee camps in neighboring Chad
- As many as 1 million civilians could die in Darfur from lack of food and from disease within coming months
- 80% of the children under five years old are suffering from severe malnutrition and many are dying each day
- Humanitarian Aid organizations have access to only 20% of those affected
- 10 years ago in Rwanda, 800,000 people were slaughtered in 100 days due to the lack of international intervention
