10 (Other) Things You Can Do To Prevent Sexual Violence

- 1 Realize that gender violence is a major social problem that deeply affects us all.
- 2 Don't remain silent – focus on how you, as an empowered bystander, can safely confront abusive behavior. THINK SAFETY – GET HELP – ACT TOGETHER
- 3 Understand how your own attitudes and actions may perpetuate sexism and violence and work toward changing them.
- 4 Gently offer your help and support if you suspect that someone close to you is being abused or has been sexually assaulted. BELIEVE THEM!
- 5 Respect others and treat others as equals. Gently challenge sexist jokes.
- 6 Support women and men who are working to end sexual violence.
- 7 Recognize and speak out against homophobia and gay-bashing.
- 8 Educate yourself and others about gender inequality and the root causes of gender violence.
- 9 Mentor and teach boys and girls about how to be men and women in ways that don't involve degrading stereotypes.
- 10 Refuse to purchase any magazines, videos, or music that portrays women or men in a degrading or violent manner.
