

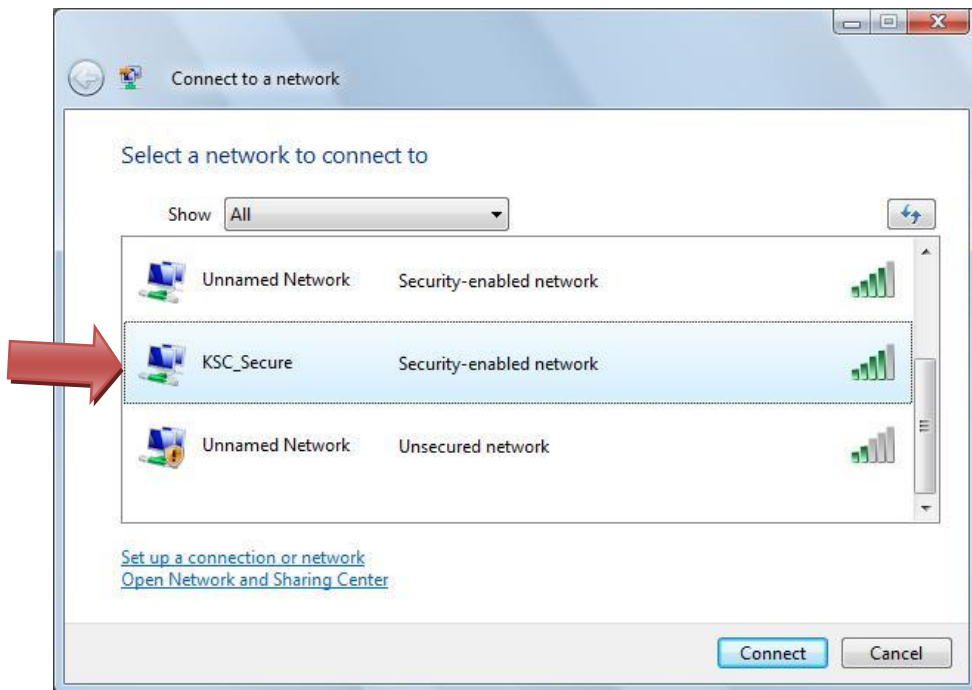
Connecting Windows Vista to KSC_Secure Wireless Network

Note: Before you begin you must be the administrator of the PC you are going to connect configure to connect to the **KSC_Secure** network. Also confirm that the date and time are correct on your PC.

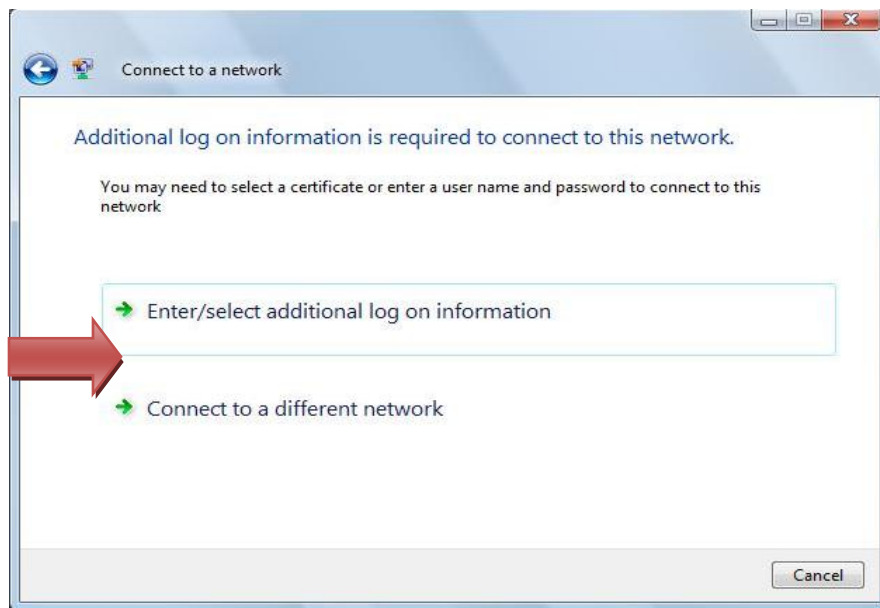
1. From the start menu, click **Connect To**.



2. From the list of available wireless networks, select **KSC_Secure** and click **Connect**.



3. Now click on “**Enter/Select additional log on information**”

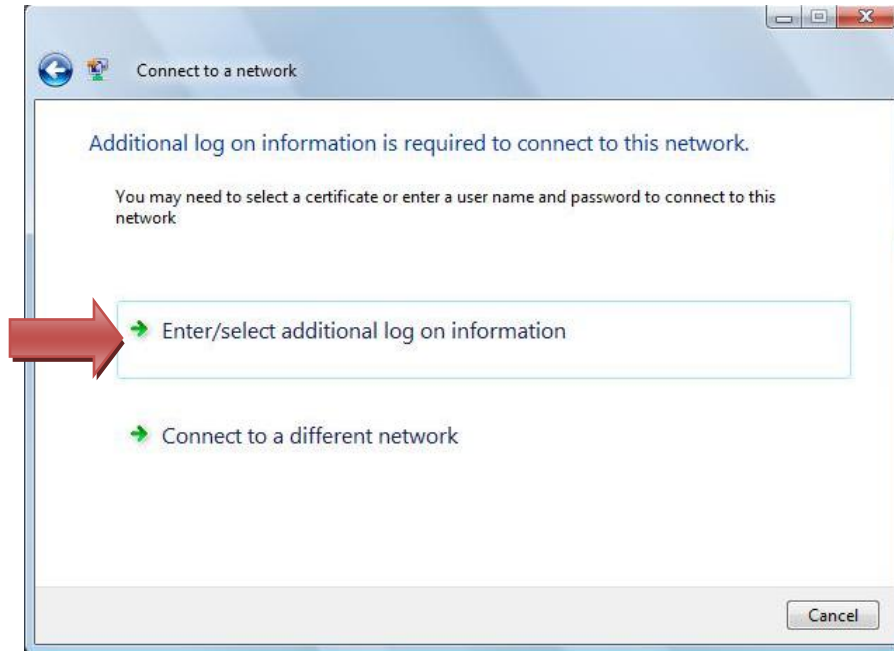


4. An “**Enter Credentials**” window will open up. Enter in your **NetID**, **Network Password**, and the **STUDENT** domain.

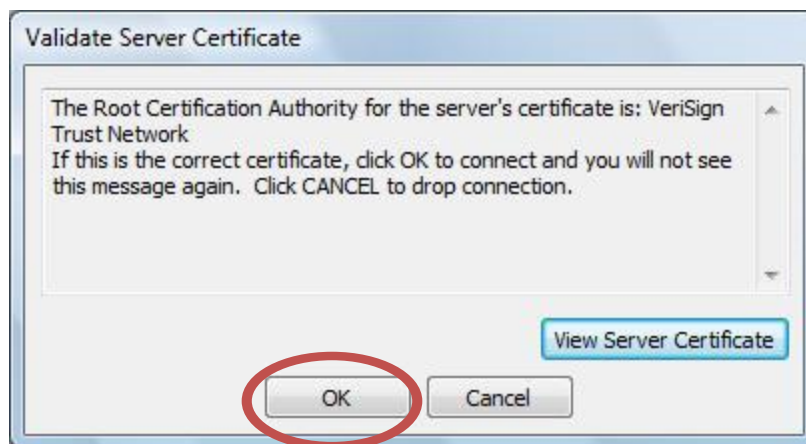


Then click **OK**.

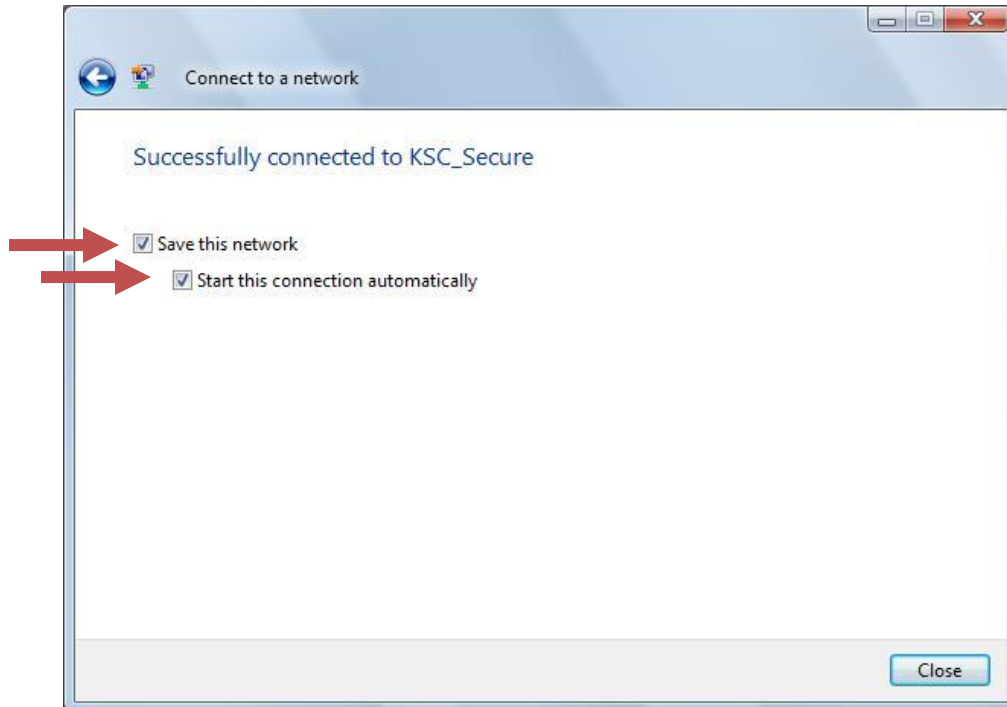
5. You will see the “**Enter/Select additional log on information**” screen **again**. Click on the “**Enter/Select additional log on information**” **again**.



6. A **Validate Server Certificate** Window will pop up. Click **OK** to accept and connect.



7. Your PC will now connect to the **KSC_Secure** network. When it has connected, you will see the **Successfully Connected to KSC_Secure** window.



8. Confirm that the **Save this network** and the **Start this connection automatically** are checked and then click close.

You are all done! Now when you are in range of the KSC_Secure network you will automatically connect. No more configuration is needed.
