The program is open to alumni of both National and international programs.

FAQ's

Q. How do I become a Global Ambassador?

A. It's easy! Stop by the Global Education Office and fill out a short application (attached.)
There is no deadline.

Q. How much time is involved?

A. You decide! The minimum commitment is 5 hours ever but you can contribute more. You can be a GA more than one semester, too!

Q. What do I have to do?

A. The Global Education Office provides a list of suggested activities for fulfilling your commitment. Activities may include: helping at orientations, answering questions at information sessions, speaking to informal groups or classrooms.

Q. What will I receive for my service?

A. Letters of recommendation, a certificate of appreciation and more! Looks great on your resume!

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Global Ambassador Tasks (you do whichever ones you feel most comfortable with)

1. Orientations: Represent your specific program as an official spokesperson at the orientations for outgoing students.
2. Study Away Fairs: Represent your specific program as an official spokesperson at our fairs for outgoing students.
3. Information Sessions: Attend an information session, (held by the GEO at various times throughout the semester) and answer questions about your exchange for potential program participants.
4. Classroom/Residence Hall visits: Attend a classroom or res hall with the GEO Study Away Advisor to speak briefly to the class about your experience.
5. Information Table: Set up in the Student Center and the GEO will provide you with materials for you to dispense. You'll also answer questions of interested students.
6. Article: Write an article about your study away experience which could be submitted to the Equinox and/or other publications on campus, including the GEO website.
7. On Call: Allow the GEO to give either your phone number or email address to students who are interested in studying on your program. You'll speak with them individually to answer their questions and help them prepare for their term away.
8. YOUR CHOICE: Think of something creative to do that will benefit the GEO. Get approval for your idea from the Program Coordinator or the GEO Director, and go for it!

Global Ambassador Contract

In order to qualify as a Global Ambassador, you'll need to commit to at least five hours ever. Above is a guideline for how you might spend the hours. Students who successfully complete the requirements of Global Ambassador are eligible to receive three exciting benefits:

1. Receive a letter of recommendation from the Program Coordinator and/or the GEO Director.
2. List the GEO as a reference on your resume
3. List your Ambassadorship with your KSC Activities

Global Ambassador Code of Conduct

As a Global Ambassador for the Keene State College Global Education Office (GEO), I agree to volunteer my services for at least five hours ever in helping the GEO promote and further the cause of study away education. I will be functioning as a representative of the program that I attended. I am free to choose the promotional activities I participate in.
