\***Undergraduate students** registered for 21 or more credits is considered in overload and will be charged the per credit tuition rate for each credit hour over 20.

\*\***All Graduate students** will be charged on a per credit basis for tuition and mandatory fees. Graduate students taking 300-400 level courses will be subject to graduate tuition rates, including those where these courses place the student in a full-time (9-15 cr) status.

**Continuing Education** courses 500 level or higher are billed at the Graduate level and rates

**Part-time students** will be charged on a per credit basis. **Undergraduate** part-time students are those carrying less than 12 credits.

\*\*\* **Optional Parent/Family fee** is charged only in the Fall semester each year.

**Returned Check Policy:** There is a \$20 service charge for returned checks. A late payment fee, if applicable, may be charged if a check is returned. This fee is in addition to the service charge. Any benefit derived or deadline met by issuing a bad check will become VOID (e.g., housing selection, registration, etc.).

**Refund Policy:** **Mandatory fees** are non-refundable once a student has officially registered. The "Tuition and Room" refund policy refunds 75% of tuition ONLY within 7 days after the start of classes (1/19/10 thru 1/25/10), a 50% refund from 8 to 30 days (1/26/10 thru 2/17/10), and no refund after 30 days (2/17/10). The "Board" refund policy is pro-rata minus 4 weeks from the date the meal ID is officially returned.

**Non-matriculated students** will pay the per credit charge regardless of the number of credits.
