

A Walk In My Shoes

Summary: After watching video clips from *Rent* and “A Walk in My Shoes,” ask yourself this question: How can you measure your existence? Maybe it's in pairs of jeans, maybe it's in scars, maybe it's even in scoops of ice cream. Choose a material object that can define you and create a multimedia presentation to visually express how it represents you and catalog your 15 years (give or take) on this planet! Your project must also express the importance of the item you chose and why you chose it.

Audience: The entire world

Form: Your choice of: a Storybird, Animoto, Prezi, Podcast, Facebook page, video, or other approved by Ms. LaFay.

Focus Correction Areas:

1. Your project must cover at least ten years of your life, with at least one image (appropriately captioned) linked to each year.
2. Your project must be professional and of publishable quality, meaning no spelling or grammar mistakes!
3. Choose three vocabulary words that define your existence (these do not need to be words that are new to you) and create a vocabulary card for each.
