

NH Presence at Gettysburg and Antietam Tour



October 22 - 24, 2013

Tuesday: We begin our travel into Civil War history aboard a fully equipped motorcoach. There will be rest stops along the way with **lunch** on our own. We'll have an afternoon arrival at our hotel. After settling into our rooms, the evening begins with a welcome reception at the hotel and a wonderful dinner at the **Historic Carriage House Inn**. Listed on the National Register of Historic Places, we will experience gracious service in an elegant country atmosphere. **(D)**

Wednesday: After our breakfast at the hotel, we travel to the **Gettysburg Visitors Center** where you will see the movie, museum and new Cyclorama of the Gettysburg battles. Next we will have a personal guided tour of the Gettysburg battlefields with special attention to the New Hampshire monuments. After our tour we will have time for lunch on our own at the Gettysburg Museum Café.

Antietam Battlefield is our next Civil War stop. Here we will have a personal guided tour of the bloodiest one day battle in American history and understand where the NH 5th was represented. Departing Antietam, we travel to **The Fairfield Inn**. Dinner will be a traditional meal that General Robert E. Lee and his Officers ate on the retreat from Gettysburg, July 4, 1863. At dinner we will have a visit from Mr. Lincoln, portrayed by Mr. James Getty. Jim Getty was commissioned to perform the voice recording of Lincoln's 2nd Inaugural address, along with the Gettysburg Address, for playback at the Lincoln Memorial in Washington, D.C. Stephen Spielberg spoke with Mr. Getty while making the award winning movie "Lincoln". **(B, D)**

Thursday: Following our farewell breakfast, we depart our hotel to visit the **National Cemetery** where Lincoln gave his Gettysburg Address. We then return to Keene with rest stops and a supper stop (on our own). We'll arrive home with incredible memories of our NH servicemen in the Civil War. **(B)**
