- b. Nominee must demonstrate continuing excellence in teaching. Previous recipients are not eligible for re-nomination.
- d. The nominee must remain an active faculty member in the year they receive the honor.

Nominations

Any member of the KSC community, including full-time and part-time students, faculty, staff, recognized student organizations, and KSC alumni, may submit a nomination.

Recommendation of Support: Must address the following four criteria:

- o Excellence in Classroom Teaching

- o Positive Attitude Towards Students and Student Advisement

Letters of Support

- o Minimum of three (3) and no more than five (5) letters of support, including:
 - o At least one (1) letter from a current student.
 - o At least one (1) letter from a colleague.
 - o One (1) letters from Keene State College alumni.

1. Excellence in Classroom Teaching:

2. Rapport with Students:

Illustrate how the nominee interacts with students, both in and out of the classroom. Of particular interest is the nominee's ability to secure the respect and confidence of their students and colleagues.

3. Encouraging Critical and Independent Thinking:

Explain the nominee's activities or methods that encourage critical and independent thinking, helping students develop constructive analytical skills and attitudes.

4. Positive Attitude Towards Students and Student Advisement:

Provide examples of how the nominee inspires students through intellectual endeavors, personal integrity, and enthusiasm for learning.
