WHAT IS THE FSA ID?

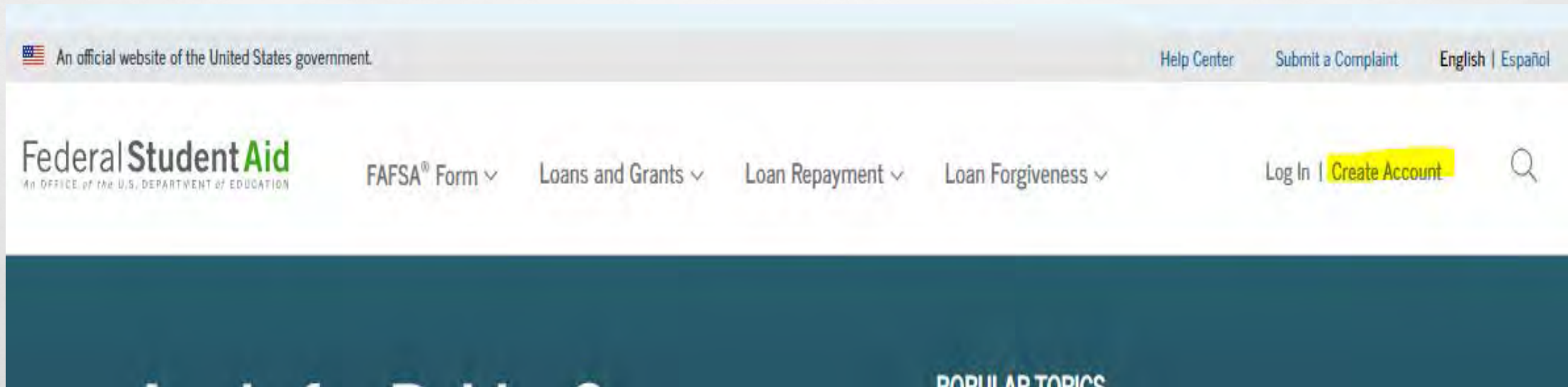
- THE FSA ID IS A USERNAME AND PASSWORD USED BY STUDENTS, PARENTS, AND BORROWERS TO:
 - LOGIN TO U.S. DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION WEBSITES
 - ELECTRONICALLY SIGN DOCUMENTS
- YOU WILL USE IT:
 - TO SIGN THE FAFSA EVERY YEAR YOU APPLY FOR FEDERAL STUDENT AID AT [STUDENTAID.GOV-FAFSA](https://studentaid.gov/afsa)
 - TO SIGN YOUR MPN WHEN APPLYING FOR A FEDERAL STUDENT LOAN
 - TO LOG IN AS A FEDERAL STUDENT LOAN BORROWER, TO SELECT A REPAYMENT PLAN OR APPLYING FOR A DEFERMENT

IMPORTANT

- Both the student and parent must create their own, unique, FSA ID
- The FSA ID is your electronic signature
- You and your parent will each need to use your own e-mail address when creating an FSA ID (you can't use/share the same e-mail address)

CREATE YOUR FSA ID (USERNAME AND PASSWORD)

Create a New FSA ID

An FSA ID gives you access to Federal Student Aid's online systems and can serve as your legal signature.

Only create an FSA ID using your own personal information and for your own exclusive use. You are not authorized to create an FSA ID on behalf of someone else, including a family member. Misrepresentation of your identity to the federal government could result in criminal or civil penalties.

To create your own personal FSA ID, enter answers for the questions below and select CONTINUE.

Important: When you are done click the CANCEL button to clear your data, even if you did not finish creating your FSA ID. Login Options

The FSA ID, which consists of a user-created username and password, replaced the PIN effective May, 2015. It allows users to electronically access personal information on Federal Student Aid Web sites as well as electronically sign a FAFSA.



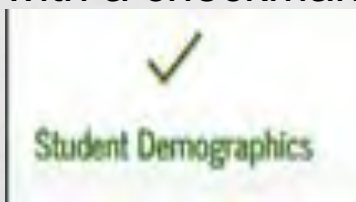
