- In order for courses to count for ISP requirements, all Perspectives courses (IH, IN, IA, IS) must be taken in different subjects.

**Take one course in each of the following areas:**

ITW (Integrative Thinking and Writing)  
 QL (Quantitative Literacy – IQL or approved other)  
 IH (Humanities)  
 IN (Natural Science)  
 IA (Fine and Performing Arts)  
 IS (Social Science)  
 II (Interdisciplinary)

**Students must also take:**

1 additional IH or IA  
 1 additional IN or IS  
 1 additional ISP (IH, IN, IA, IS, or II)
