## Wondering what happens if you may be positive for COVID-19 or have a confirmed case? Read on!

To prevent the spread of COVID-19, Keene State College has established a program that is focused on the health and safety of students and our entire community. A KSC student who has been in contact with someone who has tested positive with COVID-19 must quarantine for 14 days. A student who has tested positive or presumed by symptoms of COVID-19 must isolate for at least 10 days and until 24 hours have passed since their fever has resolved. A student will be supported and monitored during this time. They can continue class participation remotely if they are able.

### Schoolwork and Courses

A student is encouraged to communicate with their professors to let them know about their current situation and work out any plans for coursework over the following two weeks. ### **On Campus/Off Campus**

If someone tests positive or is suspected to be positive, a student who lives on campus will be provided designated housing on campus during isolation or supported to isolate at their permanent residence if preferred and can do so safely. On campus students requiring to quarantine because of possible exposure to someone positive or suspected positive for COVID-19 will need to quarantine at their permanent residence off campus. Students living off campus will be asked to isolate and quarantine at their off-campus residence, or return to their permanent residence if preferred. If any student cannot safely quarantine or isolate at their home residence, they will be provided space on campus if needed.
