The OSHA 30-hour Construction Industry Outreach Training course is a non-credit program designed for anyone involved in the construction industry. Specifically devised for safety directors, foremen, and field supervisors; the program provides complete information on OSHA compliance issues. Upon successful completion of the course, participants will receive an OSHA 30-Hour Construction Outreach DOL course completion card.

**Note:** The 30 Hour Construction Outreach course is **NOT** equivalent to the OSHA 510 or 511 courses and will not meet the course prerequisites to take the OSHA 500 or 501 courses.

This class will meet on Friday, January 17 through Monday, January 20, from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. The cost for this non-credit course is \$300.
