Granite State Award

SANDRA NEIL WALLACE & RICH WALLACE

Keene State College honors Sandra Neil Wallace and Rich Wallace with the Granite State Award. The Wallaces are award-winning authors and founders of the Daily Good, a nonprofit that provides free, culturally responsive global food pantries at Keene State College, Antioch University New England, and River Valley Community College.



Sandra and Rich also recognized today for their work to enhance health and well-being and literacy rates in our communities, as well as for their generous philanthropy focused on assisting first-generation students and students whose pathways to higher education face barriers.

When the College transitioned to online learning during the COVID-19 pandemic, the Wallaces established a Global Food Pantry on campus. While most students returned home to complete the semester, international students and other students drew support from the pantry. The pantry continues to operate, providing an important sense of belonging and a means for connection.

Rich and Sandra also established the Koenig-Siddall First Generation Scholarship at Keene State to acknowledge and address the unique challenges faced by students who immigrated to the United States or who are the first in their families born in the United States. Their scholarship considers financial need and academic standing.

The scholarship, importantly, also honors the first-generation ancestors of Sandra and Rich. Sandra is the daughter of a refugee and concentration camp survivor. Rich's great-grandmother arrived in the United States at Ellis Island from Scotland and went to work at a textile mill in New Jersey.

Between them, Sandra and Rich have authored nearly 100 novels and book-length works of nonfiction, many of which have won major awards.

Keene State College is delighted to present Sandra Neil Wallace and Rich Wallace with this award in recognition of their regard and compassion for others, including those who have less; their remarkable example; and their heartfelt friendship.

Honorary Doctorate of Humane Letters

MARCUS SOUTRA '06

Keene State College today proudly honors Marcus Soutra '06 with an honorary doctor of humane letters degree.

We bestow this degree in recognition of Mr. Soutra's groundbreaking work and visionary advancements in the field of neurodiversity and education. Inspired by his learning challenges when he was young, Mr. Soutra's work has expanded from students who learned differently to promoting and championing inclusive learning approaches in varied environments.



The College confers this degree each year on an outstanding individual of national or international importance whose contributions have enhanced society or have otherwise brought significant enrichment or benefit to a particular group.

Mr. Soutra's contributions, ranging and consequential as they are, embody the full spirit of this high honor. A steadfast focus, broadening mission, lived experience, capacity to collaborate, and track record of narrowing inequities within education structures are but some of his distinguishing qualities.

Not only is Mr. Soutra an alumnus from the class of 2006, but he is also the 2016 recipient of the Keene State College Alumni Inspiration Award.

Mr. Soutra worked as a public school teacher before joining an informal grassroots group called Eye to Eye. He became the group's first official staff member and, as co-founder and president, built Eye to Eye into a national organization with a mission to improve the educational experience and outcomes of neurodiverse young people.

An award-winning nonprofit leader, he lectures and presents nationally and internationally to reduce the stigma associated with learning differently. In March, Mr. Soutra announced that he would hand over the reins of Eye to Eye to its co-founder after 17 years to further commit to expanding his impact in the field.

In honor of his substantial and long-standing commitments to improving the lives of young people, his consistent and cogent advocacy, and the expertise that he brings to the social impact sector, Keene State College is proud to confer this degree on Mr. Marcus Soutra and to welcome him back to a familiar stage.

THE ACADEMIC PROCESSION

The academic procession is derived from European religious processions of the 12th and 13th centuries, when universities were forming but were still closely associated with the medieval church. The procession is comprised of members of the Keene State faculty and administrative staff, in order of length of service, with those with the longest tenure appearing first. This group is followed by members of today's platform party. The final two participants to move onto the stage will be mace bearer Donna Viveiros, professor of psychology, and President Melinda D. Treadwell.

THE MACE

The word "mace" is derived from the Latin "mateola," meaning mallet or staff. In the Middle Ages, these staffs, with a ball of copper or brass at one end, were used as weapons against armored warriors. As weaponry became more sophisticated, the mace evolved as a symbol of power. Universities in Europe adopted the mace as a symbol of authority and unity, and today institutions use the mace in a ceremonial capacity. A new Keene State College mace was presented to President Yarosewick by the Keene State College Alumni Association at his inauguration in 1995. Fashioned of black walnut and brass, the mace was made by Professor Charles Sheaff, a member of the Class of 1972. The mace is carried to official functions by the mace bearer, the senior faculty member in length of service.

ACADEMIC REGALIA

The caps, gowns, and hoods seen today evolved from European medieval costumes worn during religious processions to distinguish church and university members from the laity. Most medieval scholars had taken at least minor orders and, like clerics, wore long robes for warmth in unheated buildings.

Modern academic costume in the United States is based on an intercollegiate code established in 1895. Most gowns are black, although, in recent years, more American universities have allowed the use of their college colors.

The master's hood, which drapes over the back of the gown, carries the greatest symbolism of all the components of the academic costume. It dates back to the 12th century, when it functioned as a headcover and shoulder cape. The hood lining, which is exposed in the center as it lies over the back of the gown, matches the color or colors of the degree-granting institution, and the velvet trim on the hood reveals the wearer's major field of study. Those who hold more than one academic degree may wear only one hood at a time.

GONFALON

The gonfalon is the flag that leads the procession of candidates into Commencement. In the 12th century, gonfalons became the symbol of a state, family, or office. Since that time, they have become part of academic ceremonies, including commencements, convocations, and special events, such as the installation of a president. The gonfalon used in today's ceremony was commissioned by the College in 2014.

ACADEMIC HONORS RECOGNITION

Students graduating with honors from Keene State College enter the Commencement Ceremony wearing gold tassels.

INTERNATIONAL SASHES

Two groups of students wear international sashes during the Commencement Ceremony: international students and students who have participated in a Keene State College-sponsored study away program for credit. The sash represents the international student's country of origin or the host nation of the study away program.

HONOR CORDS & RED SASHES

Some graduating seniors wear cords or sashes representing membership in an honor society or honorable military service. Red sashes may also indicate participation in a recognized student organization.

THE PRESIDENT'S MEDALLION

A new tradition, beginning with the class of 2019, the President's Medallion is a gift from President Treadwell to the graduating class. The medallion ties into our College motto and our traditions of clapping in our first-year students and clapping through our graduates. When they pass through the Keene State College arch onto Appian Way, our first-year students "Enter to Learn." The President's Medallion, embossed with the words "Go Forth to Serve," is worn by our graduates when they are clapped through by the staff and faculty at the end of Commencement.

THE RECESSIONAL

Since the College's 75th anniversary year, the tradition of "clapping through" has been added to the Commencement recessional. Faculty and staff lead the recessional in two columns down the center aisle and out to Appian Way. The two rows turn and face each other, applauding as the graduates pass through. Clapping through allows the faculty and staff to congratulate the new degree recipients during the recessional.


