

## *Fraternity & Sorority Life Report Card Fall 2018*

### Scholarship/Academic Achievement

- **92** members (**48%**) of the fraternity/sorority community were on the Deans' List (3.5 or higher) this semester; of these, **19** students earned a **4.0**.
  - **30 men** were on the Deans' List; **62 women** were on the Deans' List
- Congratulations to the **Psi Upsilon new member class** for having the highest new member class GPA amongst all chapters this semester (a **3.72**).
- **7** students were inducted into the Order of Omega honor society this semester (**9%** of KSC Greeks are members of OOO).
- The **all-fraternity GPA (3.15)** is *higher* than the all-men and all-campus GPAs; the **all-sorority GPA (3.23)** is *higher* than the all-campus GPA; and the **all-Greek GPA (3.20)** is *higher* than the all-campus GPA.

### Recruitment & Retention

- **32** students affiliated with a Greek-letter organization this semester.
- **84%** of students who affiliated with a Greek-letter organization are still active members as of the end of the semester.
- **6%** of current, full-time KSC undergraduates are Greek.

### Campus Involvement & Civic Engagement

- **4,233** hours of service were completed by the entire community this semester.
- **\$4,908** philanthropic dollars were raised and donated both locally and nationally by the entire community this semester.
- **\$250+** was raised and over **30** canned items were collected by Tau Kappa Epsilon's 3rd Annual TKE-In-A-Box promoting hunger and homelessness awareness.
- **\$300+** was raised by Phi Sigma Sigma and Phi Lambda Chi during "Pie A Phi", benefitting the Special Olympics and the  $\Phi\Sigma\Sigma$  Foundation.
- **80%** of KSC Greeks are involved in at least one other student organization on campus, or volunteer at a local organization.
- The **2018/2019 Student Body President, Student Body Vice President, and University System of NH Student Trustee** are all sorority women.

### Advisor Involvement

- Each fraternity/sorority has an on-campus faculty/staff advisor to support their operational and programmatic needs. Some chapters have several advisors that support the chapter in various areas (i.e. academic achievement, financial management, membership development, alumni engagement, etc).
- Chapter advisors meet once a month during the academic year for education and training as well as to discuss common themes/trends within the community as well as to engage in discussions around how to best support and sustain KSC's fraternity/sorority community.
- Each fraternity/sorority has an alumni advisor/advisory board to facilitate and enhance alumni engagement. Four out of eight chapters have established/chartered Alumni Associations.
