

Fraternity & Sorority Life Report Card Spring 2018

Scholarship/Academic Achievement

- **110 members (44%)** of the fraternity/sorority community were on the Deans' List this semester; of these, **28 students** earned a **4.0**.
 - **30 men** were on the Deans' List; **80 women** were on the Deans' List
- Congratulations to the **Delta Xi Phi new member class** for having the highest new member class GPA amongst all chapters this semester (a **3.75**).
- **6** students were inducted into the Order of Omega honor society this semester (**9%** of KSC Greeks are members of OOO).
- The **all-sorority GPA (3.34)** is *higher* than the all-women, all-men, and all-campus GPAs; the **all-Greek GPA (3.19)** is *higher* than the all-campus GPA of 3.15.

Recruitment & Retention

- **45** students affiliated with a Greek-letter organization this semester.
- **85%** of students who affiliated with a Greek-letter organization are still active members as of the end of the semester.
- **7%** of current, full-time KSC undergraduates are Greek.

Campus Involvement & Civic Engagement

- **3,734** hours of service were completed by the entire community this semester.
- **\$13,009** philanthropic dollars were raised and donated both locally and nationally by the entire community this semester.
- **\$7,375** was raised by KSC Greeks towards the overall 2018 KSC Relay for Life goal of \$17,000.
- **\$188** was raised during the 2nd Annual Greeks vs. Athletes event benefitting the New Hampshire Special Olympics
- **\$100** was raised for the [Circle of Sisterhood](#) organization during Greek Week 2018.
- **80%** of KSC Greeks are involved in at least one other student organization on campus, or volunteer at a local organization.
- **6** student leaders from IFC & Panhel represented KSC at the 2018 Northeast Greek Leadership Association's (NGLA) annual leadership conference in Pittsburgh, PA.
- **Delta Xi Phi Multicultural Sorority, Inc.** received the 2018 Outstanding Greek-letter Organization Award.
- The **2017/2018 Student Body President, Student Body Vice President, Speaker of Student Assembly and Secretary of the Student Assembly** hold membership in a recognized Greek-letter organization.

Advisor Involvement

- Each fraternity/sorority has an on-campus faculty/staff advisor to support their operational and programmatic needs. Some chapters have several advisors that support the chapter in various areas (i.e. academic achievement, financial management, etc).
- Chapter advisors meet once a month during the academic year for education and training as well as to discuss common themes/trends within the community as well as to engage in discussions around how to best support and sustain KSC's fraternity/sorority community.
- Each fraternity/sorority has an alumni advisor/advisory board to facilitate and enhance alumni engagement. Four out of eight chapters have established/chartered Alumni Associations.
- Phi Sigma Sigma's Chapter Advisor received the 2018 Outstanding Advisor Award.
