


Research Infrastructure

Increasing our research capacity, Keene State College leveraged grant dollars to equip a 402 sq. ft. exercise science laboratory.




Number of Individuals Involved in at Least One Proposal




Number of Individuals Involved in at Least One Award




Proposals Submitted (All Sponsor Types)




Awards Received (All Sponsor Types)
